ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE POSTPONED 2026 SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL HIGH/LSEN SCHOOLS ATHLETICS CHAMPIONSHIP TAKING PLACE IN PRETORIA

The postponed South African National Schools Athletics Championship catering for High/LSEN schools' athletics is confirmed to take place in Pretoria 29 April – 02 May 2026.

Athletes competing in track and field events will participate at the championship at Pildicht Athletics Stadium in Pretoria.

Talent identification and competitions took place at cluster/circuit, district, and provincial level, enabling athletes to be selected to represent the Western Cape Province.

The final team has been registered with the national Department of Sport, Arts and Culture (DSAC) and the national Department of Basic Education (DBE) and verified by DSAC. No additional replacements are allowed, as registrations have closed.

Managers and coaches have also been appointed by Western Cape Schools Athletics (WCSA) and the respective regional/provincial federation structures, including educators employed by the Western Cape Education Department (WCED).

Furthermore, ten (10) support staff members have been appointed by the Department of Cultural Affairs and Sport (DCAS), to serve on the Western Cape General Management Team.

The WCED has appointed three (3) officials to ensure Safeguarding of Children in Sport as well as to ensure that Monitoring & Evaluation takes place at the championship itself, and to complete the necessary reports. These WCED officials will also ensure that educators comply with the relevant code of conduct of educators.

Mr Brandon Du Plessis, WCSA Chairperson, will serve as WCSA Head of Delegation and will be on duty in Pretoria, accompanied by Mr Clarence Combrink, who will serve as Team Western Cape's General Manager.

- ❖ Western Cape departs from the competition venue after the closing ceremony on Saturday 02 May 2026.

TRANSPORT

DCAS covers all the costs of transport. Eco Tours will provide luxury/semi – luxury bus transport to and from Pretoria and at the championship itself. It is a reputable company with many years of experience providing bus transport for DCAS, with qualified and experienced drivers. The necessary compliance paperwork is in order (PDPs, public liability, roadworthy certificates etc.) Qualified and experienced relief drivers will also assist with driving. Two drivers will be allocated to each bus.

NB! The various district contingents will meet in Beaufort West 19h30 - 20h30 and supper will be served in Beaufort West. Thereafter all buses leave from Beaufort West to travel to Pretoria.

ATTIRE

DCAS has procured a tracksuit, sweater, shorts, backpack and a cap for all participants. Parents/guardians are not required to contribute towards any of these attire costs.

WCSA has arranged for running gear through an appointed service provider. Parents/guardians were requested to ensure that athletes fit the running gear for orders to be placed, for DCAS to cover these costs.

As previously communicated, parents/guardians who decided to purchase running gear, or any other attire/running gear, directly from the service provider **cannot claim for any reimbursement** from the service provider, DCAS or WCSA.

ACCOMMODATION

DCAS covers all the costs of accommodation. Our provincial contingent will be accommodated at Southern Sun Hotel and Hotel 224 in Pretoria. The accommodation has been inspected, and the two hotels are located near to each other, approximately 750m apart. Support staff will be split across the two hotels to provide support to the participants.

CATERING

DCAS covers all the costs of catering. Breakfast and supper will be provided at the hotels. Lunch will be provided by a service provider appointed by DCAS. Meal preferences (normal, kosher, halaal, vegetarian etc.) have been procured.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Please note that DCAS will transport technical officials as per the list provided by WCSA. The technical officials are included in the transport plan as per the transport schedule provided. On arrival in Pretoria, the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) takes responsibility of accommodation, catering, transport, and attire of all technical officials. DCAS will **not provide** accommodation, meals, transport, and attire for the technical officials.


GENERAL
