7. ATHLETE IDENTITY VERIFICATION FORM

7.1 The SASA Executive has been mandated at a General Council Meeting (AGM) held on 9 November 2018, to implement as from 2019 the **Athlete Identity Verification Form**. See **Addendum**

7.2 It is compulsory for all athletes to present this document at the National Schools Championship as certified document for identity clarification to participate.

7.3The form must be completed in full. All details regarding the athlete, his/her original ID color photo (Not older than 6 months) must be placed on the form with the certified photocopy of Birth certificate / ID Document / Passport/ Smartcard. (Athletes that formed in Primary, High and LSEN SASA Championships for 2025 can use the same Identity Verification Form

- 7.4 Very important: Birth Certificate / Passport (All athletes younger than 18.)
- 7.5 Please Note:
- 7.5.1 The principal/ Deputy Principal SAPS qualified as Commissioner of Oath and must be certify the photocopy certificate on the template as a true copy and put School stamp (Not older than 6 months) partly over the ID photo and partly over photocopied certificate. School stamp must indicate the date.
- 7.6 The General Manager of each Province must have a list of all Athletes with the relevant information stating the date of birth of each athlete. The list must be verified and duly approved and sign-off by the Provincial Structure.
- 7.7 All Team Managers must, however, verify their athletes who finish among the TOP 6 (six) in an age category, before the medals are awarded.
- 7.8 Any Team Manager, failing to comply with this arrangement, will forfeit the athlete's medal. Provinces will be held responsible if an athlete is entered in the wrong age division.
- 7.9 Please check Template provided
- 7.10 The verification documents must be completed correctly all information must be correct. Registrar will be appointed to scrutinize the process.
- 7.11 Pre checking of the verification between the regions is needed before the provincial's events to ensure that every verification it correct. The verifications will be done as follows
- a. Boland and Central Karoo
- b. Eden and Cape Metro

SIZE OF REGIONAL TEAMS

MAINSTREAM:

Mainstream - Regions will be allowed to enter a maximum of 10 Athletes per Age Group.

A team consists of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 10 athletes for Boys and Girls.

If an age group has less than 4 athletes in the specific age group, they will not be counted to compete for the team competition in that age group.

The first four athletes of each team, completing the race, will count for points.

Regions will be not be allowed to enter more than Six athletes.

Age Groups for Boys and Girls are 9; 10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,19. Maximum of 10 athletes per team.

Regions must submit the total size of the contingent to the Western Cape Athletic Secretary on or before 22 August 2025.

L.S.E.N. (Learners with Special Educational Needs AND DEAF LEARNERS):

LSEN - Regions" will be allowed to enter a maximum of one team per Age Group. A team consists of a minimum of (4) and a maximum of (10) athletes for Boys and Girls. If an age group has less than 4 athletes in the specific age group, they will not be allowed to compete for the team competition in that age group.

The first four athletes of each team, completing the race, will count for points.

Age Groups for Boys and Girls are 14,15, 16,17,19. Maximum of (6) athletes in total, per team per region.

<u>Provinces must submit the total size of the contingent to Western Cape Athletic Secretary on or before 22 August 2025.</u>

11. MEETING FOR TEAM MANAGERS AND OFFICIALS

- 11.1 A meeting for <u>Team Managers</u> will be held on <u>Friday</u>, 29 August 2025 at Stellenbosch High School, Stellenbosch at 19:00-20:00. Only withdrawals will be allowed at this meeting.
- 11.2 Three (3) Team Managers, one for Primary Schools, one for Secondary Schools & One for LSEN from each Region, must attend this meeting.
- 11.3 The following information will be provided
 - a) Athletes' sticker
 - b) Accreditation
 - c) Safety Plan
 - d) Parking plan
 - e) Selection Criteria
 - f) Program for day.
- 11.4 Championships.
- 11.4.1 The Western Cape Schools Athletics Executive assume the responsibility for the production and issuing of the athletes' colors.

11.5 Technical Meeting for Officials

- 11.6 Competition Day 1: Technical Officials One hour before start of competition
- 11.7 Team Managers 10h00 / **12h00 and 14h00**
- 11.8 It is of vital importance that all General Managers and Technical Officials attend these meetings.
 - All the relevant General Managers and Assistants Managers as well as Technical Officials attending the various meetings must make use of private transport and attend the meetings as required They should not depend on the Team Bus for transport.
- 11.9 Officials must be dressed in **Black bottoms & White tops** for the purpose of officiating.
- 11.10 They are requested to report 60 minutes prior to the start of the meeting on Saturday.
- 11.11 Addendum A must be completed by the four regions.

SECTION D

Western Cape Team Selection – 2025

- **12.1 Western Cape Cross Country T**eam will be selected for **participation in Mpumalanga**. Each region must have one mandated representative (selector) serving on the selection panel.
 - 12.2 **Ronald Abrahams** from WCSA will be the convener of the selection panel.
 - 12.3 The official selection policy will be applied as the only criteria for selection.
 - 12.4 The convener of selectors must hand the selected team, signed by all the selectors, to the Vice-Chairperson: Cross Country (Western Cape Executive Schools Athletics Member) after the final event on the competition day.
 - 12.5 The Vice-Chairperson: Cross Country will present the selected team to the Western Cape Schools Athletics Executive for final approval, ratification and sign-off by the Chairperson and Secretary of the organization.

13 COMPETITION RULES FOR LSEN PARTICIPANTS:

LSEN Regions will be running together with mainstream according to their age group.

LSEN athletes will receive their own medals for each race.

LSEN will compete in its own team competitions.

For TRANSPORT purposes the LSEN athletes must join up with the Region/District they come from.

14. REPORTING TIME FOR RACES:

Managers of each Region/District must see to the discipline of their athletes at the place of competition and make sure that athletes report thirty (30) minutes prior to each race to the warm up area.

15. OPENING:

Opening will on Saturday, 30th August 2025 at 08h30.

16. COMPETITION RESULTS AND MEDALS:

RESULTS

16.1The official results will be posted on the official notice board on the competition day.

16.2 A Copy of the results will be available after the competition for each general manager of the four regions/ districts.

MEDALS:

Medals will be awarded to the first Three (3) athletes in each race

No team Medals

Medal recipients must assemble in a demarcated area immediately after the announcement of the results.

Athletes must wear their Regional / District colors when mounting the podium/rostrum.

17. PARTICIPATION NUMBERS:

Participation stickers & Pins will be provided at Registration.

18. FIRST AID:

First Aid & Ambulance will be on duty at the venue.

In a case of casualty or hospitalization, the athlete of the concerned region/ district will be responsible for settling any account arising from the incident.

Team Managers are advised to be in possession of each athlete's medical requirements.

19) **COMPETION RULES:**

Rules World Athletics, ASA and S.A. Schools Athletics will apply.

In the case of an appeal, an amount of R500 in cash is payable and will only be refunded once the appeal was successful. No refunds will be made if an appeal is rejected.

The appeal can be made only by the General Manager of the team and must be in writing for the attention of the Referee. (Find the necessary form attached – Addendum C.)

No parent will be allowed to communicate with the Technical Officials regarding appeals

20. GENERAL RULES

- 20.1 No littering within the grounds will be allowed.
- 20.2 Respect officials poor behavior etc. can result in suspension.
- 20.3 No alcohol, smoking or glass bottles will be allowed on the stadium.
- 20.4 Team Managers and Coaches are responsible for the good conduct and behavior of their own athletes. Disciplinary action will be taken against any defaulting Province.
- 20.5 Athletes will not be allowed to compete in any event if in the opinion of the officials if he/she is not suitably attired.
- 20.6 First Aid will be provided at the stadium in the case of injuries or emergencies.
- 20.7 A medical doctor will be on standby. The cost of treatment by this doctor will be for the account of the athlete or his/her province. Provinces are requested to provide their own physiotherapist for their team's own general purposes.
- 20.8 Athletes who belong to a medical scheme must bring their membership cards in case of a serious injury.
- 20.1 No person, except officials, will be allowed to enter the area of competition. The same apply to athletes who are not participating. Only Team Managers may enter to launch a protest.
